ENHANCED LEARNING CREDITS (ELC)

The Enhanced Learning Credit Administration Service (ELCAS) has approved a number of our ISPS courses so that subscribed Armed Forces personnel, past and present, are able to utilise their full allowance of ELC in order to gain maximum benefit from maritime training, and therefore value from their credits

MARITIME SECURITY COURSES

To meet the growing needs of both Security Officers and employers, Securewest International has developed the following courses:

COMPANY SECURITY OFFICER (CSO) (ELCAS)

This course provides instruction to those personnel who may be designated to perform the duties and responsibilities of a CSO and in particular the duties and responsibilities with respect to the security of the ship or installation. Instruction includes how to develop, implement, maintain and update a Ship Security Plan. This is an NFQ level 3 course and can be funded using Enhanced Learning Credits.

Course duration: 3 days

SHIP SECURITY OFFICER (SSO)

Offering highly detailed instruction, this course covers the security responsibilities of the person onboard the ship accountable to the Master and designated by the Company as responsible for the security of the ship as defined in the ISPS Code. This is a popular course for security operatives entering the maritime security sector.

Course duration: 3 days

PORT FACILITY SECURITY OFFICER (PFSO)

Our 3 day PFSO course is one of the most comprehensive on the market today and ensures compliance with the ISPS code. Course participants receive instruction on handling security situations, managing security training for other facility personnel and maintenance of the Facility Security Plan. Our instructors break down the regulations so that they are easy to understand illustrate key points with real life scenarios to fully test comprehension of the subject.

Course duration: 3 days



COMBINED CSO/SSO COURSE (ELCAS)

Securewest International have created a combined CSO/SSO course in order to enable candidates to obtain training and qualification in both areas on a single course. This course incorporates all duties and responsibilities of both the CSO and SSO courses and course syllabus covers all current maritime rules and regulations.

The course format centres on the teaching of the CSO syllabus and additionally covering the aspects of the SSO course not covered in the CSO. This is an NFQ level 3 course and can be funded using Enhanced Learning Credits.

Course duration: 4 days

CSO/SSO/ANTI-PIRACY COURSE (ELCAS)

This course encompasses a combination of the CSO/SSO course and covers roles and responsibilities of the Security Officer in all aspects of Anti-Piracy measures.
